The draft also provides for updating the Common Quarantine Phytosanitary Requirements for Quarantine Products and Quarantine Objects at the Customs Border and in the Customs Territory of the EAEU approved by the Decision of the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission dated 30 November 2016, No. 157 for the types of quarantine products which are allowed to be imported to the EAEU despite detection of certain pests.
