- **5. Title of the notified document:** Proposed Maximum Residue Limit: Fluopyram (PMRL2022-09). **Language(s):** English and French. **Number of pages:** 9 and 10
- **6. Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2022-09 is to consult on the listed maximum residue limits (MRLs) for fluopyram that have been proposed by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).

MRL (ppm)¹ Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

- 0.5 Cereal grains (crop group 15), except rice and corn^{2,3}
- 0.3 Rapeseeds (crop subgroup 20A) (revised)⁴
- 0.03 Green coffee beans
- 0.02 Field corn, popcorn grain²
- 0.01 Sweet corn kernels plus cob with husks removed²

An MRL is proposed for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (https://www.canada.ca/en/health-canada/services/consumer-product-safety/pesticides-pest-management/public/protecting-your-health-environment/pesticides-food/residue-chemistry-crop-groups.html) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of the Canada.ca website.

³ It is proposed that the existing MRL of 2.0 ppm for wheat bran and germ be revoked. Following the revocation of the 2.0 ppm MRL for wheat bran and germ, these wheat commodities will be regulated under the proposed cereal grains (crop group 15) MRL of 0.5 ppm.

⁴ The MRL is proposed to replace the currently established MRL of 1.8 ppm for rapeseeds (crop subgroup 20A) (revised).
