Description of content: The amendments restrict the content of crude protein in mixed feed for animals with a view to reducing surplus nitrogen emissions through animal manure due to surplus supply of proteins included in feed. Animal species concerned: pigs, layers, broilers, ducks, beef cattle, dairy cattle and cattle fiber mixed feed.
