Allow storing and distributing of hermetically sealed soybean curd, whole soybean curd and starch gel (muk) at room temperature;2. Mitigate the <i>Escherichia coli</i> standard for prepared foods in restaurants (including catering foods) to practical level;3. Establish and revise the maximum residue limits for pesticides:<ul style="list-style-type: none">– Establish the maximum residue limits for three newly registered pesticides (Isofetamid, etc.);– Expand the range of target agricultural products for 40 pesticides (Glufosinate, etc.);– Revise the definition of residues for four pesticides (Benfuracarb, etc.);4. Establish the maximum residue limits for veterinary drug (Nandrolone) in foods;5. Establish and revise the general testing methods.
