Establish and revise the maximum residue limits for pesticides: Establish the maximum residue limits for three newly registered pesticides (Isofetamid, etc.); Expand the range of target agricultural products for 40 pesticides (Glufosinate, Revise the definition of residues for four pesticides (Benfuracarb, etc.); 4. Establish the maximum residue limits for veterinary drug (Nandrolone) in foods; 5. Establish and revise the general testing methods. 7.
