This draft delegated Regulation provides additional requirements (based on Article 19(2) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625) to those laid down in a related draft implementing Regulation (notification G/SPS/N/EU/572). This draft delegated act lays down rules on specific requirements for the performance of official controls in the production process of animals and targeted towards primary products of animal origin, on the use of pharmacologically active substances, authorized as veterinary medicinal products or feed additives, and on the use of prohibited or unauthorized pharmacologically active substances, and on the residues of such substances, regarding combination of substance groups and commodities groups, and relevant criteria to be considered for sampling strategy
