Description of content: The draft Order approves the hygienic requirements for the production and placing on the market of food products of animal origin (processed and unprocessed), in particular: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- meat of domestic ungulates, hares, wild animals and wild animals raised on farms;- minced or chopped meat (minced meat), meat semi-finished products and meat of mechanical rolling;- meat products;- live bivalve molluscs, live echinoderms, live gastropods and live marine gastropods;- fish products;- eggs and egg products;- frog legs and snails;- melted animal fats and crackers;- processed stomachs, bladders and intestines;- highly purified chondroitin sulfate, hyaluronic acid, other hydrolyzed cartilage products, chitosan, glucosamine, rennet, fish glue and amino acids;- gelatin and collagen. The requirements establish rules for food market operators on the hygiene of food products of animal origin, their production and placing on the market. The draft Order is developed based on the requirements of the EU legislation, namely Regulation (EC) No. 853/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April
