Description of content: This Resolution contains provisions on the maximum tolerated limits (LMT) of contaminants in foods, the general principles for their establishment and the methods of analysis for the purpose of conformity assessment.

This Resolution incorporates into the national legal framework:

- I GMC/MERCOSUR Resolution No. 103, 15 December 1994;
- II GMC/MERCOSUR Resolution No. 25, 20 June 2002;
- III GMC/MERCOSUR Resolution No. 12, 17 July 2011; and
- IV GMC/MERCOSUR Resolution No. 18, 13 October 2021.

This resolution is the result of the consolidation of previous regulations, which the content has not been changed.
