6. Description of content: MPI is amending the Import Health Standard: *Grain and Seeds for Consumption, Feed or Processing*. The import health standard dated 2 February 2023 replaces the earlier version of the standard dated 22 December 2022.

The amendment is to remove the following viruses form the *Phaseolus* spp. and *Pisum* spp. pest list, along with the specific import requirements for these viruses in the specified hosts:

Phaseolus spp.:

- Broad bean mottle virus
- Cowpea severe mosaic virus
- Pea early-browning virus
- Peanut mottle virus

Pisum spp.:

- Peanut mottle virus
- Peanut stunt virus

Consultation is not required for this amendment. This is because consultation was conducted when removing these organisms from the seeds for sowing import health standard (the highest-risk pathway for the import of seeds) and no concerns were raised during the consultation period.
