- **6. Description of content:** The New Zealand Ministry for Primary Industries is publicly consulting on the following proposed amendments to the import health standard 155.02.06: *Importation of Nursery Stock*:
  - Amending the current onshore chemical treatment options for *D. deremensis* whole plants and non-dormant cuttings;
  - Adopting the onshore chemical treatment options to all whole plants and non-dormant cuttings *Dracaena* species eligible for importation into New Zealand;
  - Adding a spraying option for the application of the onshore chemical treatment for whole plants and non-dormant cuttings of *Dracaena* species;
  - Clarifying that onshore treatment is mandatory for all whole plants and non-dormant cuttings *Dracaena* species.

Transferring the *Dracaena* onshore treatment requirements to the New Zealand Approved Biosecurity Treatments Standard (ABTRT).
