#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 3 May 2023, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

### Established Maximum Residue Limits: Spiropidion

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for spiropidion notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1471 (dated 25 January 2023) was adopted 19 April 2023. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

## MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

7.0	Dried tomatoes
5.0	Potato flakes
3.0	Dry soybeans
1.5	Potatoes, tomato paste
1.0	Bell peppers, non-bell peppers
0.9	Cantaloupes, muskmelons (other than those listed in this item), pumpkins, watermelons, Winter squash
0.8	Cucumbers, tomatoes
