The following communication, received on 3 May 2023, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

### Established Maximum Residue Limit: Sodium acifluorfen

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for sodium acifluorfen notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1470 (dated 25 January 2023) was adopted 19 April 2023. The proposed MRL was established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and is provided directly below:

MRL (ppm)<sup>1</sup> Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

0.06 Carrot roots
