 - [X] Trade facilitating measure Although the labelling of unintentional mingling of allergens is neither compulsory nor regulated in the European Union, traces of allergens below the allergen-specific threshold are usually labelled with general terms such as "nuts" or "edible nuts". In order to ensure that products destined for the European market can also be placed on the Swiss market without further trade barriers, unintended mingling of allergens shall be labelled with the group name.
