Description of content: The measure authorizes the change in the conditions of use of 2'-Fucosyllactose to remove the obligatory condition that, when 2'-Fucosyllactose is used in combination with Lacto-N-neotetraose in infant formula and follow-on formula and in milk-based drinks and similar products intended for young children, at the currently authorized levels of up to 1,2 g/l, they should be used only at a 2:1 ratio (two parts 2'-Fucosyllactose to one part Lacto-N-neotetraose).
