- **6. Description of content:** Import requirements and internal measures are put in place in relation to the Tomato brown rugose fruit virus.

Furthermore, new scientific information has been collected since 2020 on the spread of the specified pest, on testing methods and on resistant varieties. Therefore, urgent measures taking into account updated information are taken to prevent the further introductions into and limit the spread of this pest within the European Union.
