Description of content: The objective of the notified document PMRL2023-34 is to consult on the listed maximum residue limit (MRL) for fludioxonil that has been proposed by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA). <u>MRL (ppm)¹ Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u> 4.0 Sugar beet roots ² ¹ ppm = parts per million ² This MRL is proposed to replace the currently established MRL of 0.02 ppm.
