	This draft resolution aims to correct the identified inconsistency between the definition of virgin oils and the definition of virgin oils; improve the definition of compound oils and fats; clarify the framework and denomination of mixtures of vegetable oils and fats; correct inconsistencies in the denomination of hydrogenated vegetable oils and fats and standardize the terminology used to refer to the "sales denomination".
