- **Title of the notified document:** Proposed Maximum Residue Limit: Sulfuryl fluoride (PMRL2016-48). **Language(s):** English and French. **Number of pages:** 5
- **Description of content:** The objective of the notified document PMRL2016-48 is to consult on the listed domestic and import maximum residue limits (MRLs) for sulfuryl fluoride that have been proposed by the Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).

- 3.0 Crop Group 14-11: Tree Nuts (except almond nuts and pistachio nuts)²

MRLs are proposed for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/cps-spc/pest/part/protect-proteger/food-nourriture/rccg-gcpcr-eng.php) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of Health Canada's website.
