- **6. Description of content:** The notified draft measure establishes:
 - Phytosanitary requirements for canola (Brassica napus L.) seeds produced in Uruguay and the United States;
 - Requirements for *Trogoderma granarium* contained in grains for consumption of coriander (*Coriandrum sativum*), millet (*Pennisetum glaucum, Pennisetum miliaceum*) nutmeg (*Myristica fragrans*) and pepper (*Piper nigrum*);
 - Phytosanitary requirements for grain species only if contained in mixtures for animal feed (pets);
 - An additional declaration for countries to declare that a pest is not present in the country of origin, following the guidelines of ISPM 8.
