- 6. **Description of content:** The requirements for Syrah declined in sections 3.1 and 3.2 of the *Vitis* schedule from the "Ministry for Primary Industries Standard 155.02.05: Importation of Nursery Stock" has been amended to clarify that they only apply to Syrah cultivars of *Vitis*.
