## NOTIFICATION

### *Addendum*

The following communication, received on 13 May 2024, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the United Kingdom.

Details of planned amendments to England, Scotland and Wales (Great Britain) retained legislation (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072)

[G/SPS/N/GBR/39](#) of 27 July 2023 provided information on proposed updates to pest measures. Following a review, it was discovered that *Pinus parviflora* Sieb. & Zucc. (*Pinus pentaphylla* Mayr) was omitted in error from Annex 6, part A, point 1 of the assimilated law Phytosanitary Conditions Regulation (2019/2072), which references species of Bonsai trees which can be imported into Great Britain from Japan. This change will enter into force on 31 May 2024.
