<b>6. Description of content:</b> This Draft Uganda Standard applies to dandelion greens consisting of either plants or cut leaves of varieties (cultivars) grown from <i>Taraxacum officinale</i> F.H. Wigg. to be supplied fresh to the consumer, dandelion greens for industrial processing being excluded. The standard shall not be applicable to mixtures of plants and cut leaves in the same container.
