- 6. Description of content: The draft provides for amendments to the actions of the inspectors conducting veterinary inspections of third countries' establishments, it also authorizes competent authorities to exclude enterprises that have not supplied the goods (products) under control to the customs territory of the Eurasian Economic Union for 5 years from the Registry of Establishments authorised to export to the Eurasian Economic Union. The draft also specifies the conditions under which exports of the goods (products) under control from a third-country enterprise are subject to suspension. As well, the draft determines the procedure for the initiator of a joint verification (inspection) of third-country enterprises with respect to the suspension of exports from the enterprises that refuse to carry out verification (inspection) though being selected for it.
