  - Commodity/Product and Recommended Specification for Acrylamide:

The recommended specification for processed cereal products and ready-to-eat foods have been revised to apply only to roasted, baked, or fried.

- Operating period: From 1 February 2025
- Action for Exceeding Recommended Specification:
  - Encourage manufacturers, processors and importers of products exceeding the recommended specification to comply with and improve the recommended specification (notify inspection results to manufacturers, processors, or importers, refrain from importing the products, etc.)
