#### Addendum

The following communication, received on 3 December 2024, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of New Zealand.

Amendment to the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) Import health standard 155.02.06: Importation of Nursery Stock

MPI has issued an amended import health standard 155.02.06: Importation of Nursery Stock, effective 28 November 2024. The amendments include:

- 1. Remove the measures for Hoya undetermined tobamoviruses (pre-determined testing in post-entry quarantine).
- 2. Remove Hoya undetermined tobamoviruses as a quarantine pest in the Hoya schedule of the Nursery Stock standard.
- 3. Add phytosanitary measures for the management of Orthotospovirus alstroemerinecrosis (Alstroemeria necrotic streak virus (ANSV)) and Orthotospovirus tomatoflav (Tomato chlorotic spot virus (TCSV)) on Hoya plant hosts, including options for off-shore and on-shore management.
